



Group C02- ABS FUND Forestry Partnership as Conflict Resolution of PT. REKI Concession in Jambi Province

Forest tenure conflicts acute in forest areas is increasing. Forest areas use permits seems to be a trigger of conflict between communities and concessionaires. Consortium and owner has been acquire a legal way to obtain forest utilization license from the government. People with limited capital claim have been already exist and cultivated the forest areas for their living before concessionaires get its legal permit. Each of them try to defense their right toward forest area. The objective of the research is to identify the encroachment group and to study the implementation efectivity in forest patnership as conflict resolution in concnesion area of PT. REKI. The method used in this research is desk study, survey and field studies to obtain data and information related to the implementation of government policy conflict resolution. The data will be analyzed descriptively and studies based on facts in the field and scrutinize policy concepts that have been issued by the Ministry of Forestry. The result indicates that implementing empowerment of local communities through partnerships forestry concept, which stated in the Ministry of Forestry Regulation No. P.39/Menhut-II/2013. The patnership pattern of implementation concept can be found in concession area of PT. REKI, which is between PT. REKI with Suku Anak Dalam (SAD) Group, that is PT. REKI supplies the facility and tool in efforting to SAD that support ecosystem restoration of hutan harapan. Based on number of survey is known that the society has stayed in concession area can be classified in some catagories: 1) The poor worke/labour; 2) The poor farmers (≤ 2 Ha); 3) The farmers (≤ 10 ha); 4) Farmer bussinesman/investor (100-200 Ha); 5) Out comers with special frequency visiting; 6) The society who informally has the land, but lives in out consseion of PT. REKI. Both the society groups and PT. REKI still does not find the conflict finishing agreement which is about forestry partnership. Those parties are still in negotiation process. The implementation of forestry partnership as conflict resolution of PT. REKI concession needs to be encourage and serious actions from all parties to achieve the best conflict resolution.
